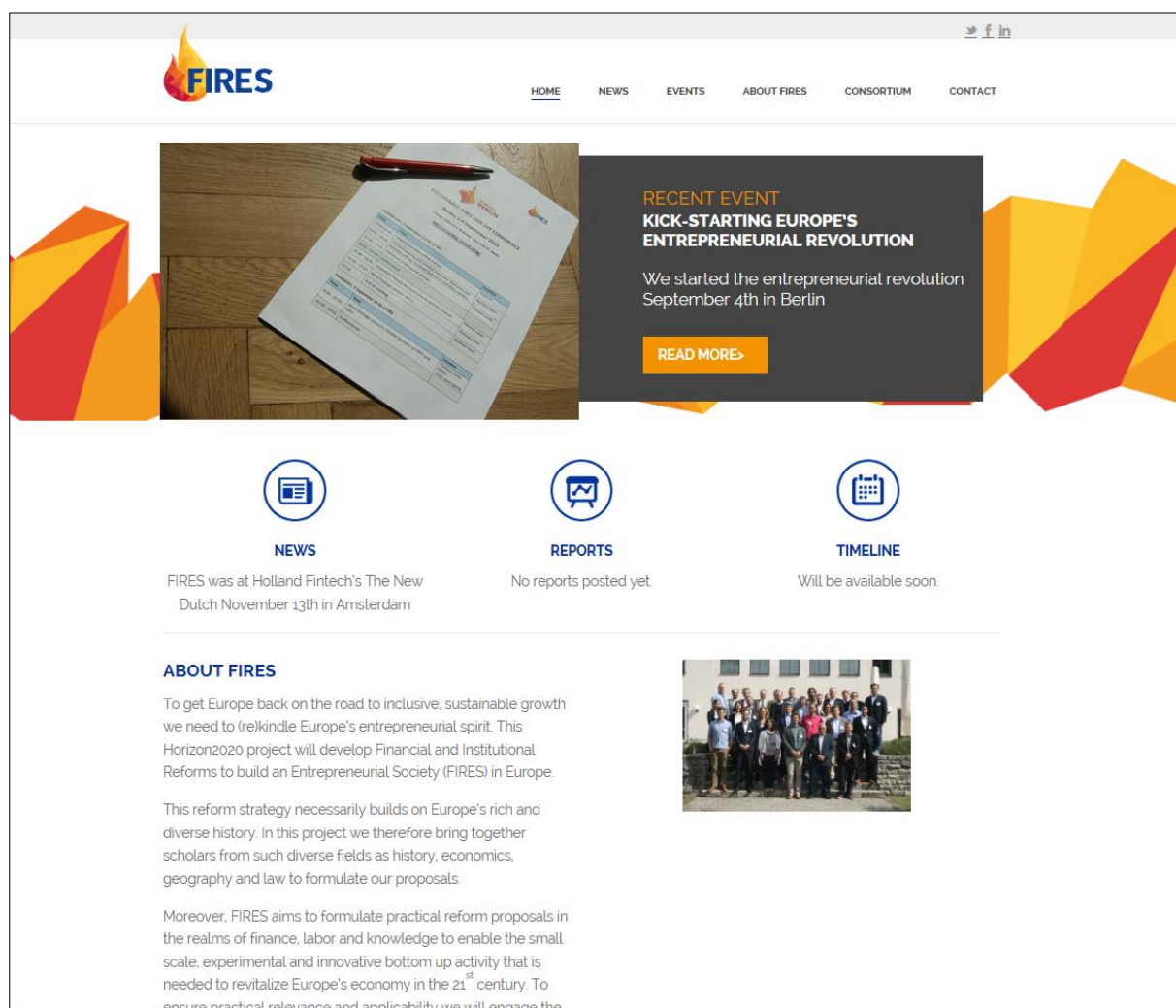



## Summary
